It was beautiful to see all of our students back for the beginning of Term 3. After a well-deserved break, our teachers were excited to see all of their children's smiling faces and have some fantastic new learning to share with them this term.

As a whole school, we are going to be focusing on a few issues which have shown they are impacting our community.

Classes will be learning about aspects of cyber safety and cyberbullying. Parents can help us with this by;

- 1. Having access to the social media your children use*
- 2. Respecting the age limits for social media and not letting your child access this prior (13 years old)*
- 3. Checking your children's safety settings and ensuring they are on private*
- 4. Checking what type of photos they are posting and if they are appropriate*
- 5. Not allowing them to "friend" people they do not know*
- 6. Supervising your children when they access the internet*

7. Encouraging them to discuss concerns and block unkind people

8. Making sure you NEVER share your private details or anyone else's private details

This term, there will be follow up with students and families if we are provided evidence of cyberbullying. If students are treating each other disrespectfully through this media, it will result in student suspensions or other consequences. As a community, we can support our children to treat each other with respect at all times.

This term, we will also be focusing on the ***respectful treatment of all community members***, which includes both children and adults. This will mean parent meetings and follow up with families for any inappropriate comments, such as;

- Racist comments
- Personal insults
- Family insults
- Verbal harassment
- Inappropriate language

Students will be working with their teachers to manage conflict in more appropriate ways, and we would value parent/caregiver support in making our school a positive place to spend our days.

We will also be focusing on encouraging school attendance, and there will be positive rewards for classes with 100% attendance for three or more days a week.

Positive attendance is;

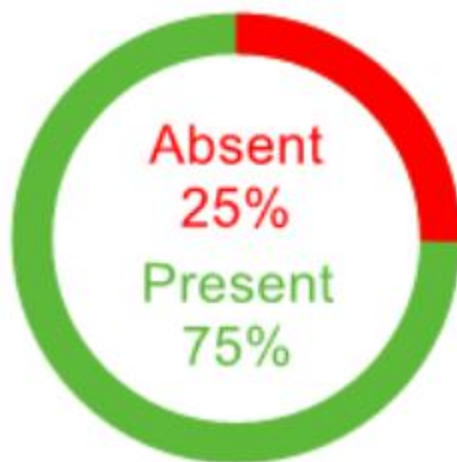
- Being at school by 9:00 am

Learn how to say our Kurna name, *Pur - lah - chi*, this means number 2!

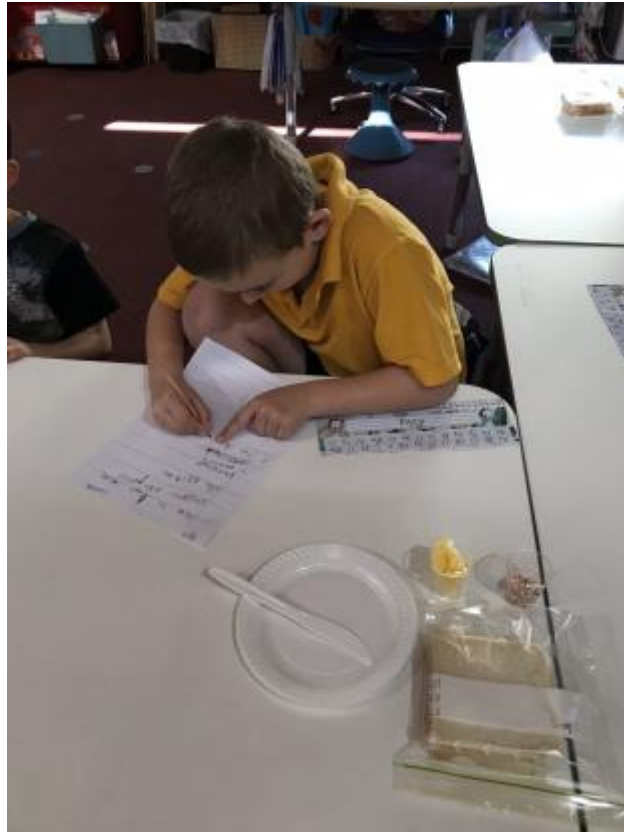


Purlaityi worked hard last term writing procedural texts, learning about the past and practising our communication and social skills .

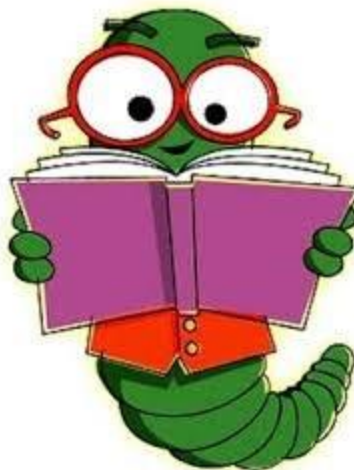
Library News
